

PARTICIPANTS' MEDICAL OR OTHER CONDITIONS RESTRICTING TRAVEL:

At the time of reservation for the pilgrimage, each participant will advise Immaculate Heart of Mary in writing (a confirmed email shall constitute written communication) of any medical condition (including food or other allergies) or physical disability or limitation, which might reasonably be considered to pose a danger to the participant's safe travel during the pilgrimage. After review of such information, Dube Travel may, at its sole discretion, either reject such reservation and refund the initial deposit or require written advice from the participant's physician(s) that such conditions do not pose a risk to his or her safe travel. Dube Travel or Immaculate Heart of Mary will not be responsible for any loss, injury or harm to a participant occasioned by any medical condition, or physical disability or limitation, not previously disclosed.

PROOF OF CITIZENSHIP: A valid United States Passport is required for travel to Europe. Please note the expiration date of such passport must be later than six (6) months from the date of a participant's return to the United States. For non US Citizens, they must consult their consulate to verify entry requirements into Poland. If you have any questions, please contact S. Mary Ann directly.

SAFE ENVIRONMENT COMPLIANCE: As minors are expected to be a part of this pilgrimage, anyone born prior to August 1, 1995 is required to be in compliance with Diocese of Brooklyn Safe Environment policies, including but not limited to: background check, VIRTUS Training
